give you thanks and praise.

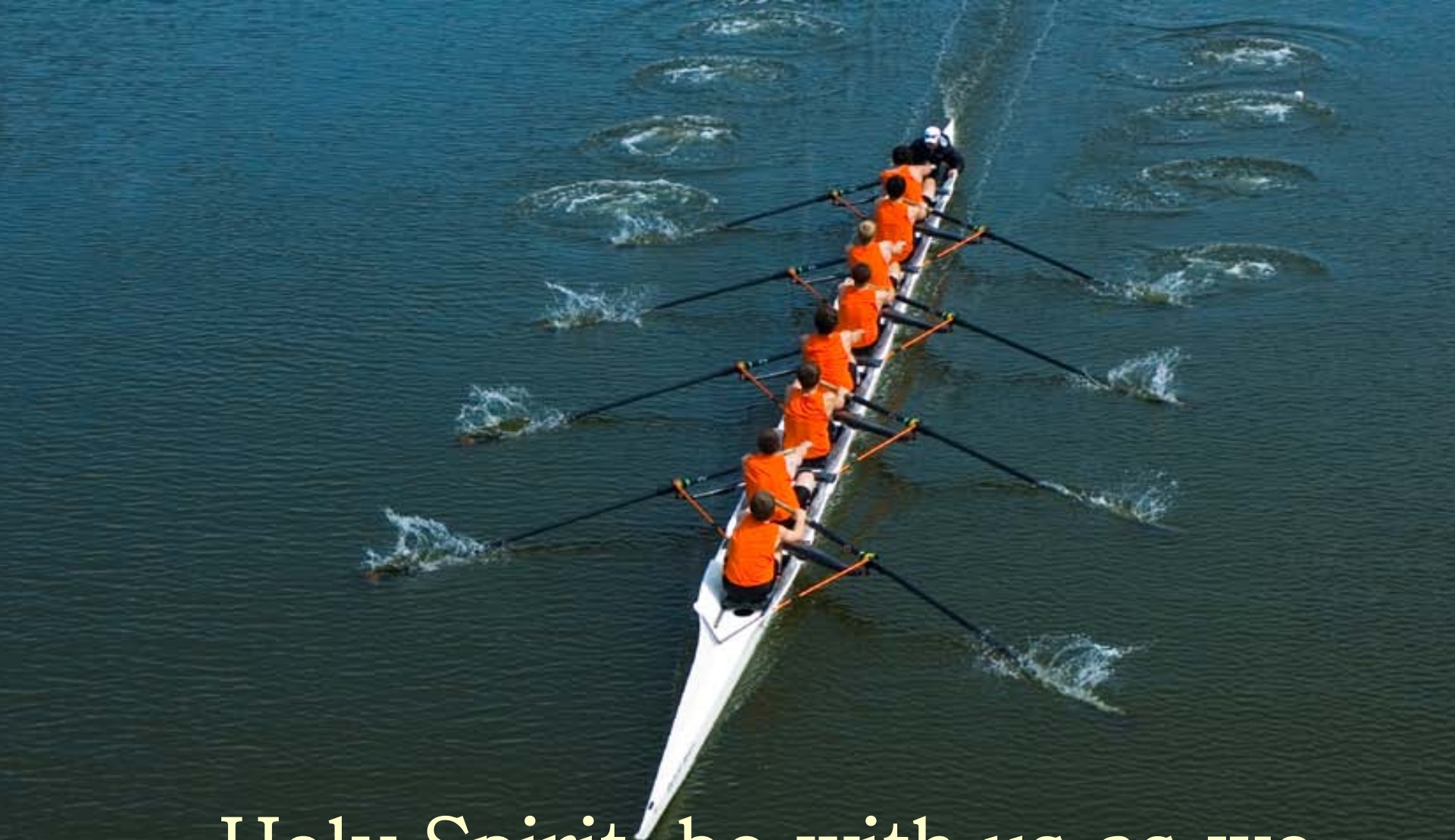


For the summer we have shared
