

# Tóraíocht

The Postgraduate Diploma in Educational Leadership (Tóraíocht), is offered jointly by the Leadership and Planning, PDST team and the Education Department, NUI Maynooth. The programme is supported by the Department of Education and Skills.



**Tóraíocht aims to enhance participants' current work and to support their preparation for future senior leadership and management positions. It aims to develop the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and skills required for successful modern school leadership.**

The programme is delivered through a blended model of facilitated sessions and on-line workshops in parallel with individual and group projects and presentations. It will be presented, subject to sufficient applicants, over one academic year between September 2011 and June 2012 in the following centres:

**NUI Maynooth and Education Centres in Castlebar, Drumcondra, Kilkenny and Tralee.**

#### Induction:

Induction will take place in NUI Maynooth on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2011 (attendance compulsory).

#### Assessment:

Assessment on this programme is varied and continuous. Between September and June participants will be asked to complete a number of module related assignments, a portfolio of their learning journey and a leadership focused action research project.

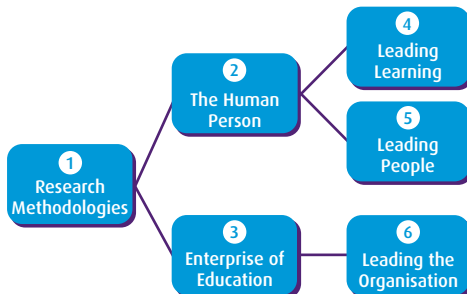
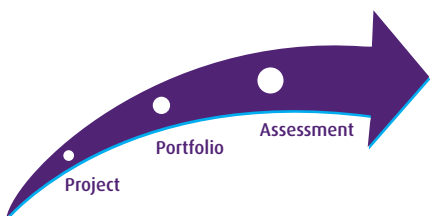
#### Application:
